On Tuesday November 25th, 2014, Betty Anstey of Oliver suddenly and tragically passed away in Oliver at the age of 73 years.

She was predeceased by her parents John and Ruby Newman and her brother Bill Newman.

Betty moved to Oliver in the early 1970's from Kamloops. She was very well known around Oliver and was constantly walking her route.
