

REMEMBERING
Cesar Soares

December 1, 1929 - December 23, 2009



On Wednesday December 23, 2009, Mr. Cesar Soares of Oliver, passed away peacefully at McKinney Place Extended Care Unit at the age of 80 years.

He was predeceased by his son Fernando on May 24, 1975 and his half brother Chris Campos.

Prayers were held at 7:00 P.M. Tuesday December 29, 2009 at Christ the King Catholic Church. A funeral mass was celebrated by Fr. Sebastian Puthenpura at 11:00 A.M. Wednesday December 30, 2009 at Christ the King Catholic Church. Cesar was laid to rest in the Oliver Municipal Cemetery following mass.
