

REMEMBERING Dalvir Gill

May 8, 1942 - June 23, 2022



Sardar Dalvir Singh Gill was born May 1942, in modern day Pakistan in the small village Chak 233B. In the years where he and his brothers were supposed to play, he witnessed the devastating effects of the partition. In the years following the partition, life's hardships continued. His mother passed away when he was only 9 years of age. He was educated for his metric in Nathowal and continued to obtain his FSC degree from GHG Khalsa College in Sudhar. Getting married at a young age Dalvir Singh never shied away from responsibilities, he turned down a governmental job in public relations to take care of the family's land. As the eldest son in the family he worked endlessly to support his family. He was a hard worker his whole life and even when he came to Canada in 1997 he worked long days regularly to assist his family. He spent the last few years of his life dealing with medical issues that ended up defeating him on June 23rd 2022.
