On December 18, 2010, Mr. Domingos Humberto Ferreira of Kaleden passed away peacefully in his sleep at the Penticton Regional Hospital at the age of 75 years.

Domingos was a religious man, he was a long time member of the Knights of Columbus and spent time at bible college. He also coached soccer at a high level with youth and adult teams.

Prayers were recited at 7:00 P.M. Sunday December 26, 2010 at St. John Vianney Catholic Church. A funeral mass will be celebrated by Fr. Pat Monette at 10:30 A.M. Monday December 27, 2010 at St. John Vianney Catholic Church. Interment will
