Dorothy was active in her communities through her involvement with St. Elizabeth's Catholic Women's League in Stockholm Saskatchewan, the executive of the Girl Guide & Boy Scout organization in Stockholm, St. Anne's Catholic Parish Church, and the Catholic Women's League.

As a member of the Catholic Women's League, Dorothy served on the executive,

organized funeral luncheons and helped with numerous parish activities. She also volunteered with Mariposa Gardens reading program, and provided square dance entertainment for various clubs and senior facilities throughout the valley.

Dorothy's passion was cooking and baking. No one ever went hungry when they came into her home. She loved to provide meals or baked goods for anyone in need. When able, she was the chauffeur for events in the community, especially the community theatre. She was also an accomplished horseback rider.

Dorothy and Peter started Square Dancing in 1954 in Saskatchewan and continued dancing throughout their lives in B.C. Peter, a square-dance caller and teacher with Dorothy assisting, made numerous friends throughout Canada and the United States.

A Prayer Service will be held on Thursday July 27, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. and a Funeral Mass on Friday July 28, 2017 at 10:30 a.m., will be held for Dorothy, both at St. Anne's Catholic Church, 7610 - 87th Street, Osoyoos. B.C.
