It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of our beloved Husband and Father, Joe Liebel on May 14th, 2023.

Joe was born on March 14, 1930 in Loon Lake SK and moved to Osoyoos in the early 40's with his family. He was predeceased by his parents, John Sr. and Rosalia, his siblings Ludvina (Rubner), Edward, John Jr., and Mary (Moreau).

He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Christine, his children Mark, Anita and Karen, in-laws Pearl, Linda & Dominic, Bridget & Rod, Liz, and countless nieces and nephews.
