With deep sadness we announce the passing of Kaj Bye-Jensen. He passed away at his home surrounded by his loving family on Thursday, December 15, 2016 at the age of 77 years.

Kaj will be fondly remembered by his loving family including his devoted wife Joan, his sons Niels (Mandy) and Lars, and his grandsons Clay, Colby, and Curtis.
