Ken Doepker, born in Humboldt, Saskatchewan, February 14, 1946. Passed away peacefully, December 4, 2009 after a year long battle with esophageal cancer. He is survived by his wife of 42 years, Trude; 2 children, Jeff (Erin), and Jacquie (Fraser); grandchildren, Devon and Ryan; parents, Ted and Kay Doepker; and 6 brothers and sisters. Ken began his career after receiving his RN in 1967 at St. Elizabeth's Hospital in Humboldt. He went on to receive his BScN from University of Saskatchewan in 1971, and his Masters in Health Services Administration at the University of Alberta in 1980. Ken was an avid sportsman and grew up playing hockey, baseball, racquetball, squash, handball, tennis, and golf. Ken was a strong believer in family and community service.
