It is with sadness we announce that Paul Edward Gifford passed away peacefully in his sleep on January 5, 2024.

He is predeceased by his parents, Henry and Elsie Gifford and his brothers, James and David Gifford.

Paul is survived by his wife, Mary Gifford of 47 years; his daughters, Rachel and Rebekah; grandchildren, Joshua-Caleb, Ezra, Seth, Mathias, Samuel, Maiden; his brother, Philip, and his nieces and nephews.

Paul was born and raised in Brockville, Ontario. He moved west to Jasper, Alberta, working for CN, where he met his future wife.

Paul never let anything stop him from pursuing his goals. He continued to enjoy art and hunting, tackling any perceived limitation with single-minded tenacity.

He was a man of intense passion and committed faith, never giving up hope of a brighter tomorrow. His loss will be felt by many.
