

REMEMBERING Ralph Mcnutt

December 1, 1940 - June 7, 2016



It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Ralph McNutt on June 7, 2016 in Oliver, BC. Ralph passed away peacefully surrounded by his family, after a courageous battle with cancer. He was predeceased by his wife Carol in 1997 and is survived by his children Todd (Joanne), Susan (Brent MacNeil) and Nancy (Shannon Scott); grandchildren Gavin, Kerri, Owen and Tanner; his brothers Ken (Carole), Brian (Rose) and Mel.

Ralph was born in Winnipeg, Manitoba and moved to Calgary in 1952. He joined the Calgary Police Service in 1962, and retired after 25 years in the rank of Staff Sergeant.
