On Saturday March 10, 2012, Mr. Richard Harland (Dick) Bird of Oliver passed away at the McKinney Place Extended Care Unit at the age of 82 years.

He was predeceased by his parents Richard and Agnes Bird; three brothers and three sisters.

Dick will be fondly remembered by his loving family including wife Beatrice; son Terry (Neena); daughters Cheryl (Darryl) and Lynn (Brian); seven grandchildren; one great-grandchild and extended family.

Dick proudly served for twenty years and travelled the world in the Royal Canadian Navy as a Warrant Officer.
