On Tuesday August 19, 2014, Roy Lewis Smart of Oliver passed away suddenly in Penticton Regional Hospital at the age of 69 years.

After a medical retirement, he moved to Alberta to help with his grandchildren, and returned to Oliver, BC in 2009.

He loved hunting, camping and fishing and spent most of his free time on the mountain. He loved his family and his friends and was always the first to offer help when it was needed. He always enjoyed learning about history, science and airplanes.
