On Monday December 23, 2013, Mr. Theodore (Ted) Hannas of Oliver passed away at the South Okanagan General Hospital after a short battle with cancer at the age of 86 years.

It was a wonderful move as Ted and Eva became very active in the Seniors Centre and did a lot of traveling but the activity that Ted loved most was dancing.
