After the death of her husband, in 1996, Winnifred continued to travel to southern California in winters, and enjoyed the Okanagan and her family in the summers. Although she was unable to travel in the last few years of her life, she continued to enjoy living in her own home with the help of her three wonderful caregivers

Jeanne, Karen and Arlene.

Winnifred was an immensely proud and beautiful woman with strong opinions and great convictions. She adored her family and cherished her friends. She passed away with a clear mind and a passion for life.
